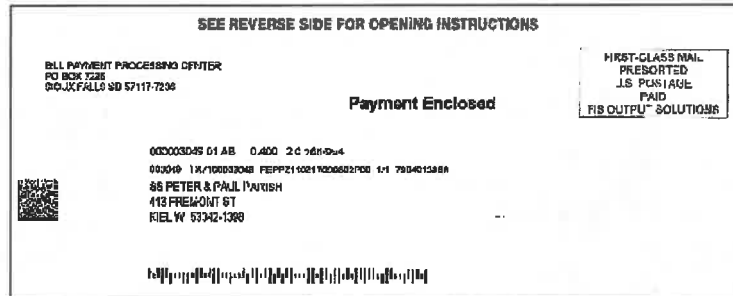


WeShare | Online Giving



*Stewardship is about being grateful, responsible stewards of the gifts we receive from God.*

**Stewardship Giving** - Put your contribution in the offering basket as a loose offering or a check. If you wish to have your offering recorded for tax purposes, please use your envelope (be sure to include your name) or indicate "stewardship" in the notes section of your check.

## Bank Bill Pay

While Stewardship Giving is the most common opportunity to give, many of our congregants have asked for the option of making a payment automatically through their bank's bill pay option. Automatic Bank Bill Pay, sometimes called Electronic Funds Transfer (EFT), is set up directly with your banking institution; many banks offer this as a free service to their customers (some with requirements like having direct deposit, e-statements & a debit card). Talk to your bank for specific details they may require. This payment method allows you to set up an automatic draft withdrawal from your checking account without having to write or mail checks. If you pay your bills on-line, you are already familiar with the "Bill Pay" service from your banking institution. You may use this same service to make contributions to the church by setting up SS. Peter &

Paul (413 Fremont St, Kiel, WI 53042) as one of your "vendors". (If you know your church envelope number, please put that on the "account number" line.) The church will receive the check and will easily be able to credit your account. Your contribution will appear on your giving statement. To set up an automatic bank bill pay you will be required to contact your banking institution directly; logging on to the bank website is the most convenient but a phone call or visit to the bank may also be an option. You can set up a one-time payment in an amount of your choosing or set up recurring payments. You choose the frequency of payments and when during the month the payments are made. Most banks send email reminders. Payments can be changed or stopped at any time.

## WeShare On-line Giving (see reverse side)

**Q** *What is on-line giving?*

**A** An electronic contribution is an automatic transfer program which allows you to make contributions without writing checks. A small fee is charged to the church, based on the amount of the transaction.

**Q** *How is my electronic contribution automatically deducted from my account?*

**A** Once you authorize the transfer after you set up an account in WeShare, your specified contribution is electronically transferred directly from your checking or savings account to our account on whatever date you specify when setting it up.

**Q** *If I do not write checks, how do I keep my checkbook balance straight?*

**A** Since your contribution is made at a pre-established time, you simply record it in your check register on the appropriate date.

**Q** *Without a canceled check, how can I prove I made my contribution?*

**A** Your bank statement gives you an itemized list of electronic transfers. It is your proof of contribution.

**Q** *What if I change bank accounts?*

**A** Go on-line and log into your account in WeShare and make the change there.
